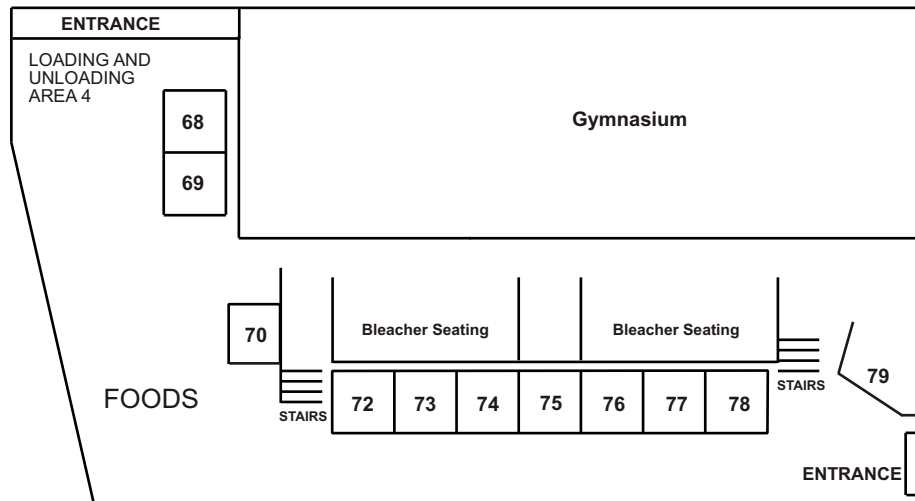

UPPER LEVEL FLOOR PLAN

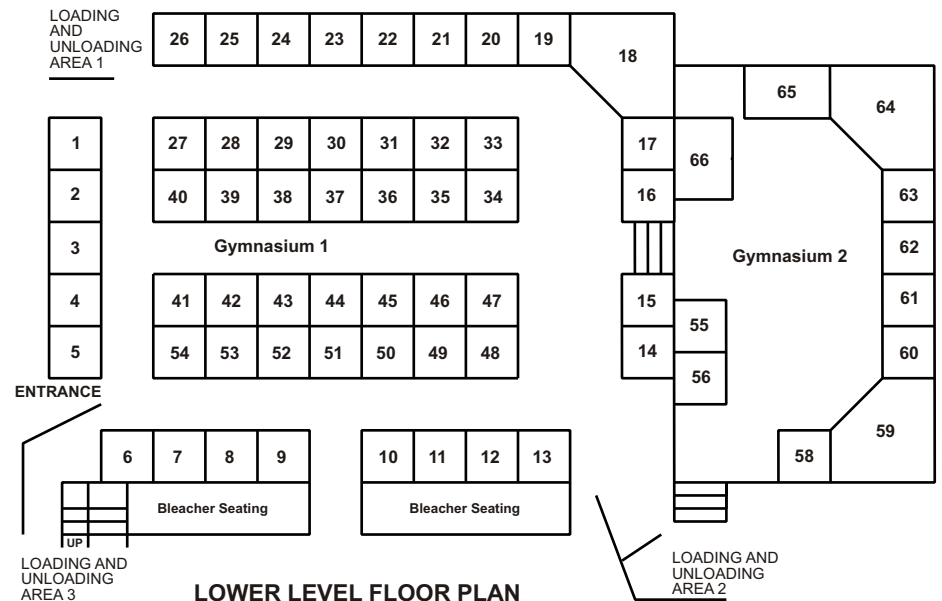
