Five \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to Atlantic Canadian students at NSAC studying in a program leading to a Bachelor's degree with a major in Plant Science (Agronomy or Horticulture) or Environmental Landscape Horticulture. Preference will be given to students who have course and project work that reflect a commitment to environmental issues and career interests in growing plants (including farming). Selection criteria are academic performance, financial need and career plans. Applications must be submitted to NSAC Awards Office by September 20.
