

NSAC Sport Leadership Award

The \$1,000 Sport Leadership Award recognizes a high school varsity athlete enrolling full time in a program of study and planning on participating in a sport at the varsity level at NSAC. Applicants must be maintaining a minimum 75% average in the courses required for admission to NSAC to be eligible. Recipients of other major entrance scholarships are not eligible. Selection criteria include financial need, sport skills and leadership. The Sport Leadership Award may be renewable for one year, conditional on the recommendation of the varsity coach(es) in the sport(s) of participation and an average of at least 65% from the first year of full-time study.

Applications (including two letters of reference including one from a high school coach to comment on excellent sport skills, athletic ability, team leadership, coach ability, positive attitude) and a resume must be submitted to NSAC Awards Office by May 14, 2012.
