NSAC Career 2012 Fair is just a few days away!

There has been a link placed on our website listing hotel accommodations <http://nsac.ca/careerfair/hotels.asp> for those of you who are traveling.

Student Volunteers are available to assist with your needs for the day, including unloading and loading your vehicles, booth set up and tear down. Our Student Volunteers will be wearing **bright green T Shirts** and will be available to answer questions, give you directions, and provide you with anything you need during the day.

A Welcome Booth will be set up at the front doors of the gym, lower level. Please enter the Langille Athletic Centre, via the lower level. There will be Student Volunteers waiting to assist you.

Please park your car in front of the stairs leading to the lower level, unload your vehicle (a student will assist you and take your booth items to your space) and park across the road behind Chapman House (College Road).

The Pipe and Drape will be set up by 10:30 am and **you are asked to come and set up your booth between 10:30 and 11:45.**

Lunch will be provided, as will refreshments during the day. If you are alone in your booth, please indicate to our welcome staff that you will need a break and a Student Volunteer will watch your booth for you during that time.

Please email me if you need internet or power for your booth as this will help to create a floor plan that works well for all. In addition, if you have allergies or food requirements, please email me so that I may arrange for a menu that accommodates all.

Please bring your own Extension Cords and supplies needed to open boxes and set up displays.

The Career Fair is being held at the Langille Athletic Centre, 12:00 - 5:00 and our students will typically come in shifts, depending on their class schedule **so please do not plan to tear your booth down until after 5:00.**

A Welcome Package, including Name Tags will be provided, as will an Exit Survey. We ask you to please return your Name Tag at 5:00 and please pass in your Exit Survey to our Student Volunteers as they will be collecting them mid-afternoon.
