#### What is the NSAC Internationalization Award?

The NSAC Internationalization Award is intended to recognize and encourage activities by faculty, staff and students that contribute to internationalization at NSAC.

Examples of contributions to internationalization include: international project work, curriculum development, international awareness activities and student development. Consideration will be given to the impact of this activity on faculty, students and staff, the level of innovation in the activity and length of time the nominee has been involved in international activities.

#### Who is eligible?

Nominees will normally be faculty, staff or full time students. An individual or a team may be nominated.

In rare cases, a person from outside the College community who has made an outstanding contribution to internationalization at the College will be considered.

An individual will be eligible to receive the award not more than once in three consecutive years.

#### What is the Nomination Procedure?

Complete a nomination form (attached, or call Michelle Richards, NSAC International, 893-6514)

Self-sponsored nominations are permitted.

Nominations must include two supporting letters from faculty, staff or students.

Following the nomination deadline, the nominee will be informed and asked if they wish their name to stand. Nominees will be asked to provide a copy of their curriculum vitae outlining their contributions to internationalization of the NSAC.

The Dean of Internationalization will chair the selection committee, which will include a representative of NSAC International, one student representative, and three NSAC faculty or staff members. The award will be presented at the May convocation.

#### Nomination Deadline:

All nominations must be submitted to NSAC International by **Monday, March 8.**
